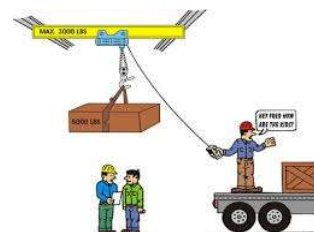
Insurance Open Enrollment for BLI Employees

Load Securement – Securing Tips

- Use proper equipment, in good condition
- Chains must be free of kinks and stretched links
- Straps must be chafe and cut free
- Use edge protectors when needed
- Although you may go outside the rub-rail, stay inside when possible. They are there for the protection of your tie-down
- Do not anchor to a rub-rail. Rub rails are not designed as anchor points. Generally, stake pockets are strong enough to be used as anchor points.
- Pipe standards are not to be used as a part of pipe securement
- Bobby Lehmann trucking requires two (2) straps or chains on every item loaded on trailer regardless of length or weight.

| 2/3 c. Canned Pumpkin | |

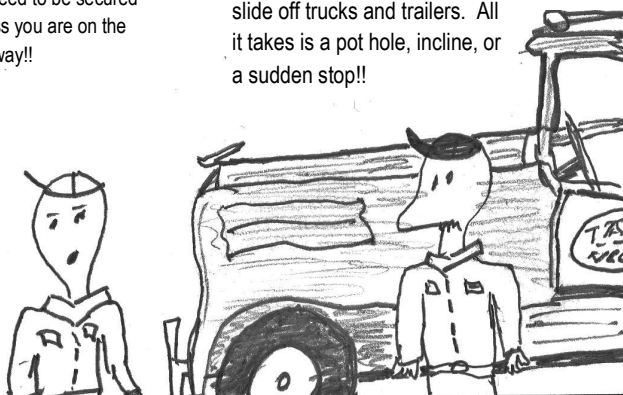


Mix first 7 ingredients together. Pour in greased 10x16 cookie sheet pan that is lined with wax paper sprayed with cooking spray. Bake at 375 degrees for 15 minutes. Turn out on a towel, sprinkled with powdered sugar. Roll up long ways and let cool. While cooling, mix filling starting with cream cheese, vanilla, butter, & powdered sugar. Unroll cake and spread filling on cake. Roll up again and put into refrigerator to cool & set. Slice and serve!
