

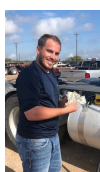

Beyond Professional – Letter from a Company

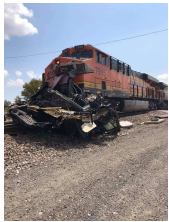
Tim,

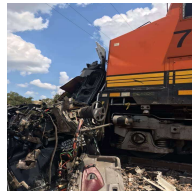
I had to share this with you, as far too often in work all we hear about is the complete opposite of what is written above. Have a great weekend and we will continue to stay in touch with heavy haul loads.
